

**Law 5128/2024 (A' 118) "Provisions concerning the Digital Educational Portal and the Digital Tutoring Platform, career guidance in secondary education, measures to support the educational system in remote areas, and other provisions of the Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs and Sports".**

**Article 70**

**Religious Communities – Amendment to article 13(paragraph 1) and addition of article 18A to Law 4301/2014**

1. In point (A) of paragraph 1 of Article 13 of Law 4301/2014 (A' 223), concerning the recognition of the legal personality of the Catholic Church in Greece, other existing Churches, and their legal entities, sub-point 86 is added as follows: "86) 'Holy Monastery of the Brothers Servants of the Lord and of Our Lady of Matara, Religious Legal Entity', seated in Tinos."
2. In point (E) of paragraph 1 of Article 13 of Law 4301/2014, sub-point 28 is added as follows: "28) 'Holy Monastery of the Salesian Fathers of Saint John Bosco, Religious Legal Entity', seated in Syros."
3. Within an exclusive time limit of one (1) year from the entry into force of the present Law, the religious legal entities referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 shall complete the procedure provided for in paragraph 2, Article 13 of Law 4301/2014, concerning the recognition of the legal personality of the Catholic Church in Greece, other existing Churches, and their legal entities.
4. In Law 4301/2014, following Article 18, Article 18A is added as follows:

**"Article 18A**

**Support measures for religious communities that  
have Suffered a holocaust or genocide  
recognized by the Hellenic Parliament**

1. Religious communities that have suffered a holocaust or genocide recognized by law and that constitute legal entities governed by public law or ecclesiastical or religious legal entities under Article 13 may, upon application submitted to the Directorate of Religious Administration of the General Secretariat for Religious Affairs of the Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs and Sports, receive assistance and support measures from the Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs and Sports. The assistance referred to in the first subparagraph may also be granted, under the same procedure, to non-profit schools associated in any manner with the religious communities of the first subparagraph.
2. The assistance and support measures for the religious communities and schools referred to in paragraph 1 aim at preserving their distinct cultural identity and at linking such identity with Greek history and culture, and shall be determined by specific legislation in respect of each one."
