



### **05-03-2020 Results of the 2nd Panhellenic student competition “Two Hundred Years since 1821”**

The results of the 2nd Panhellenic student short film competition on the theme “Two Hundred Years since 1821”, organized by the General Secretariat for Religious Affairs of the Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs, in cooperation with the Special Committee on Cultural Identity of the Holy Synod of the Church of Greece, as part of the official celebration of the 200th anniversary of the start of the War of Independence, are hereby announced.

During the 2019–2020 school year, students of the third grade of middle school created short films inspired by one of the following personalities of the Greek Revolution: Ioannis Makrigiannis, Domna Visvizi, Bishop Joseph of Roga, a National Martyr, and Theodoros Kolokotronis.
