



09-03-2020 Results of the 6th student short film competition on the theme “The Holocaust and the Greek Jews”, school year 2019–2020

On Thursday, March 5, the results of “The Holocaust and the Greek Jews” competition were announced, following the evaluation of the competent committee. The winners of the competition, organized by the General Secretariat for Religious Affairs of the Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs in cooperation with the Jewish Museum of Greece, will participate in a special annual educational program of the Jewish Museum of Greece that includes an educational visit to the Auschwitz Museum (for the current school year, the visit will take place when conditions permit it).

During the 2019–2020 school year, 111 valid entries were submitted by 46 schools from the Regional Directorates of Attica, Central Macedonia, Epirus, Crete, the Peloponnese and Central Greece, and specifically from the Secondary Education Directorates of A', B', C' and D' of Athens, East and West Attica, Piraeus, East and West Thessaloniki, Arta, Heraklion and Arcadia. A total of 304 students participated.

The top five awards will be given to the short films entitled “Roots That Are Never Lost” of the 1st Day Vocational High School of Arta, “Never Again” by the American Farm School, “No One Returned” by the Fryganiotis Schools, “Shipwrecked in History” by the Moraitis School and “Song in Memory” by the 9th General High School of Athens (the order does not constitute a ranking), while 41 honorary mentions will be awarded to 29 schools. A total of 120 students from the first and second grades of high school will participate in the educational program, which will conclude with a closing meeting to be held at the Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs.
