



**09-11-2018 Student short film (video) competition on the theme “The Holocaust and the Greek Jews”, school year 2018–2019**

The General Secretariat for Religious Affairs of the Ministry of Education, Research and Religious Affairs and the Jewish Museum of Greece are organizing a student short film (video) competition on the theme “The Holocaust and the Greek Jews.”

Students in the first and second grades of High School from the following Directorates of Secondary Education may participate in the competition until January 15, 2019:

- East and West Attica
- Piraeus
- East and West Thessaloniki
- Kastoria
- Arta
- Trikala
- Arcadia
- Chania
- Rethymno
- Heraklion
- Lasithi

The winners will take part in a special educational program organized by the Jewish Museum of Greece, which includes, among other things, an educational visit to the Auschwitz-Birkenau State Museum in Poland.

The theme of the competition is the Holocaust of the Jews during World War II, with special emphasis on the Greek Jews. Through their work, students are asked to express their thoughts

and feelings on the subject, as well as to reflect on its significance and relevance in modern life.

Students participating in the competition will become familiar with scientific and historical research and will become researchers of the past through the exploration and study of primary and secondary historical sources. Furthermore, the competition provides an opportunity for students to engage with the history of World War II and the Holocaust in Europe and Greece, as well as with the history of their local community.
