13-03-2023 Results of the Panhellenic student competition “Memories of Asia Minor–Pontus: 1922–2022”, school year 2022–2023

The results of the Panhellenic student short film competition on the theme “Memories of Asia Minor–Pontus: 1922–2022”, organized by the General Secretariat for Religious Affairs of the Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs, in cooperation with the Special Committee on Cultural Identity of the Holy Synod of the Church of Greece, as part of the commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the Asia Minor tragedy are hereby announced.

Students of the second and third grades of middle school created videos inspired by one of the following personalities, who were either born and raised or played a significant role in Asia Minor and Pontus: Basil the Great, Archbishop of Caesarea; Euthymius, Bishop of Zela (Saint and National Martyr, 1921); Filio Haidemenou; and Nikolaos Kapetanidis (Hero of Pontus, 1921).

Five (5) Awards and three (3) Honorary Mentions are granted, as follows:

AWARDS to students from the following schools:

- 4th Middle School of Corinth – “With the Pen as a Weapon” (Nikos Kapetanidis)
- 2nd Experimental Middle School of Kilkis – “Nikos Kapetanidis – The Film”
- Middle School of the I.M. Panagiotopoulos School – “Nikos Kapetanidis: Pontic Call
- 2nd Middle School of Serres – “Filio Haidemenou Narrates...”
- 11th Middle School of Thessaloniki – “Basil the Great: A leading hierarch”

HONORARY MENTIONS to students from the following schools:

- Ecclesiastical Middle School–High School of Xanthi – “Basil the Great: The persecution from his homeland”
- Music School of Tripoli–“Nikos Kapetanidis-The unconquered pen of Pontus”
- Youth Protection Foundation “Saint Polycarpus – Saint Georgios” – “Memories of Asia Minor – Saint Basil”

A total of twenty-four (24) students from the second and third grades of middle school will participate in an educational visit to Nafplio.
