

15-12-2022 Debriefing meeting and presentation of honorary mentions for the 8th student short film competition on the theme “The Holocaust and the Greek Jews” for schools in Thessaloniki


On Wednesday, December 14, 2022, a debriefing meeting and a presentation of honorary mentions to the awarded students of the 8th student short film competition on the theme “The Holocaust and the Greek Jews”, as well as certificates of participation to their teachers, were held in the “Manolis Anagnostakis” Hall of the Thessaloniki City Hall, in the presence of the Secretary General for Religious Affairs, Mr. G. Kalantzis, the Mayor of Thessaloniki, Mr. K. Zervas, and the President of the Central Board of Jewish Communities in Greece, Mr. D. Saltiel. Certificates of participation were also awarded to the students’ teachers.

During the 2021–2022 school year, despite the adverse conditions of the pandemic, thirty-two (32) schools participated in the competition, submitting fifty-nine (59) films created by one hundred and fifty (150) students of the first and second grades of high school. The students who were awarded in the 8th student competition took part in an educational program of the Jewish Museum of Greece, which included a preparatory meeting and an educational visit to the State Museum of Auschwitz-Birkenau in Poland.

During the meeting, the students were given the opportunity to share their experiences, thoughts, and feelings about their participation in the educational program. This was followed by the presentation of twenty-two (22) honorary mentions to the distinguished students from the following schools of Thessaloniki: E. Mantoulides Schools, 1st General High School of Panorama, 3rd General High School of Kalamaria, 27th General High School of Thessaloniki, and 7th General High School of Thessaloniki.

The meeting was also attended by awarded students from the 6th and 7th student competitions who also visited the Auschwitz-Birkenau State Museum after the restrictions on school trips, which had been imposed for public health reasons over the past two years, were lifted.
