17-12-2018 Student short film (video) competition on the theme “Two Hundred Years since 1821”, school year 2018–2019

The General Secretariat for Religious Affairs of the Ministry of Education, Research and Religious Affairs and the Special Committee on Cultural Identity of the Holy Synod of the Church of Greece are organizing a Panhellenic student short film (video) competition for the 2018–2019 school year on the theme “Two Hundred Years since 1821.”

Students in the third grade of Middle School from all over Greece may participate in the competition until February 19, 2019.

The winners will take part in an educational program, which includes an educational visit to Mystras.

The central theme of the competition is the Revolution of 1821. Specifically, for the 2018–2019 school year, students are asked to create a short film (video), inspired by one of the following pre-revolutionary personalities:

- a. Rigas Velestinlis
- b. Saint Kosmas
- c. Saint Philothei
- d. Daskalogiannis

Through their work, students are asked to express their thoughts and feelings on the subject, as well as to reflect on its significance and relevance in modern life, drawing inspiration especially from the lives and work of the personalities on whom the 2018–2019 school year competition focuses.

Students participating in the competition will become familiar with scientific and historical research methods and will themselves become researchers of the past through the

exploration and study of historical sources. Furthermore, the competition provides an opportunity for students to engage with the history of the Greek Revolution, as well as with the history of their local community and the heroes of the revolution.
