23-10-2020 3rd Panhellenic student short film competition on the theme "Two Hundred Years Since 1821"

The General Secretariat for Religious Affairs of the Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs and the Special Committee on Cultural Identity of the Holy Synod of the Church of Greece, on the occasion of the bicentennial of the Greek War of Independence, are organizing, for the third consecutive year, a national student short film (video) competition on the theme "Two Hundred Years Since 1821."

Students in the 2nd and 3rd grades of middle schools all over Greece may participate in the competition until February 26, 2021, either individually or in groups of up to three, under the supervision of a teacher.

The winners, provided epidemiological conditions permit, will take part in an educational program that includes an educational visit to the Prefecture of Magnesia and an awards ceremony.

The central theme of the competition is the Revolution of 1821. Specifically, students are asked to create a short film (video) of up to six minutes in length, inspired by one of the following personalities of the Greek Revolution period:

1. Konstantinos Kanaris
2. Ioannis Kapodistrias
3. Evanthia Kairi
4. Father Konstantinos Oikonomos of the Oikonomos Family

Through their creations, students will have the opportunity to express their thoughts and feelings on the subject and reflect on its significance and relevance in modern life, drawing inspiration especially from the lives and work of the personalities on whom the competition focuses during the current school year.

Moreover, participants will become familiar with scientific and historical research and will also become researchers of the past through the study and analysis of historical sources.

The competition serves as an opportunity for students to engage with the history of the Greek Revolution, as well as with the history of their local community and the heroes of the revolution.

It should be noted that the competition will be held in strict compliance with health protocols for managing epidemiological risks, taking into account the relevant guidelines of the Ministry of Education and Religious Affairs and the National Public Health Organization for protection against COVID-19.
