On Tuesday, February 25, 2025, the results of the student competition for the creation of a historical narrative and a poster on the theme “Asia Minor – Pontus: Memories” for the 2024–2025 school year were announced, following the committee’s evaluation.

The prize winners and honorees of the competition, organized by the General Secretariat for Religious Affairs of the Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs and Sports, in cooperation with the Special Synodical Committee on Cultural Identity of the Holy Synod of the Church of Greece and the Chair of Pontic Studies of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, will participate in an educational visit to the regional unit of Imathia, to locations related to Greek history and the culture of Pontus.
