30-09-2024 Panhellenic student short film (Video) competition on the theme “Orthodoxy and Hellenism in Cyprus – 50 Years since the Turkish Invasion”

The General Secretariat for Religious Affairs of the Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs and Sports and the Special Synodical Committee on Cultural Identity of the Holy Synod of the Church of Greece, on the occasion of the completion of 50 years since the Turkish invasion of Cyprus, which led to the occupation of 37% of the island, are organizing a national student short film (video) competition on the theme “Orthodoxy and Hellenism in Cyprus – 50 Years since the Turkish Invasion.”

Students of the 2nd and 3rd grades of Middle School from all over Greece may participate in the competition until February 25, 2025, either individually or in groups of up to three, under the supervision of a teacher.

The winners will take part in an educational program, which includes an educational visit to Kalamata and an awards ceremony.

During the current school year, the central theme of the competition is creative reflection on the Christian roots and the presence of Greek culture in Cyprus. Specifically, students are invited to create a short film (video) of up to six minutes in length, inspired by one of the following figures, who were either born and raised in Cyprus or played a significant role there:

- a. Apostle Varnavas,
- b. National Martyr Archbishop Kyprianos (1821),
- c. Evagoras Pallikarides (1957) and
- d. Eleni Foka (“The Teacher of the Occupied Territories”).

Through their creative work, students will have the opportunity to engage with the history of Cypriot Hellenism, express their thoughts and feelings on the subject, and reflect on its significance and relevance in modern life, drawing inspiration in particular from the life and work of the figures on whom the competition focuses during the current school year.

In addition, students will become familiar with scientific and historical research and will themselves act as researchers of the past through the exploration and study of historical sources.
